



Dr. Thanos is a great instructor and i comprehend many crucial details in its class.




He was a good teacher, always polite and willing to help.





Its a great course for researchers


My main issue with the course was how you handled the move to online courses. I thought the decision to give a 5-hour take-home exam was incredibly unreasonable and insensitive. No in-class exam would last that long, and while we have access to the notes for a take-home, that in no way makes it reasonable to create a five-hour test. If you needed to test us on all cumulative material a midterm should have been given in the same take-home format to reduce the size of the final. This approach was neither helpful nor beneficial to my learning in the class. And while this is not a problem for myself, many students have internet and connection problems, as well as adjustments in transforming their homes into offices. With all of that, a five-hour test seemed more like a power move instead of an actual test on the class's understanding.

The course was great. I learned a lot that will be useful to my masters research. Both Dr. Gentimis and our lab instructor Dongran Zhao made sure we understood the material and were always willing to help if we did not.

I feel that we could have learned more advanced things in some topics but I understand not all people have the same eagerness to learn about statistics.



#### (AG-05) Overall, I would evaluate this course as excellent.






## (AG-07)Is this course required for your degree?



## (AG-08)How many class sessions during the semester did you miss?




## (AG-09)What is your expected grade in this course?





# (AG-10)What is your current LSU GPA?




